

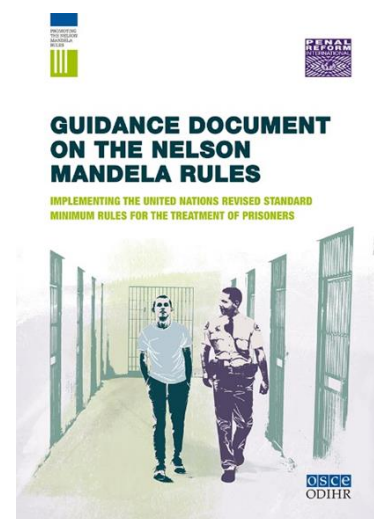
Implementing the UN Nelson Mandela Rules on the Treatment of Prisoners: new guidance and country experiences

At this event a new Guidance Document by OSCE/ODIHR and Penal Reform International on the Nelson Mandela Rules will be launched. The Guidance Document is a practical tool for penitentiary staff, prison administrations, monitoring bodies and relevant policymakers on the implementation of the revised UN Standard Minimum Rules for the Treatment of Prisoners. It will assist stakeholders in improving conditions of detention and the treatment of prisoners in the OSCE region, with a specific focus on torture and other ill-treatment.
